The Château de Montfrin has
been an important site for
centuries, and always played
host to travelers and statesmen
including Saint Francis of Assisi,
Saint-Louis, Louis XIII, and
Molière. Today the Château
is surrounded by 200 hectares
of vineyards and olive orchards
which are all farmed organically.
