**Varietal:** 60% Pinot Noir, 40% Pinot Meunier

**Vineyard:** Cumières Premier Cru

**Vinification:** Indigenous yeasts. 20% oak, 80% stainless steel vats. No malolactic fermentation

**SO2:** 10 mg/L at press

**Aging on the lees:** 2 years

**Dosage:** Extra Brut



### About the winemaker:

Vadin-Plateau was founded in 1785 amongst the charming terroirs of five neighboring villages: Ay, Damery, Champillon, Hautvillers, and of course, the home of the winery, Cumières. Since 2012, the 7-hectare estate has been committed to organic viticulture and has abstained from using herbicides for over two decades. The wines produced at this domaine are not only typical of the region, but also highly personal,

as each cuvée possesses a unique identity of its own. Vadin-Plateau produces an impressive selection of single-vintage, single-vineyard wines that reflect the distinct terroirs of the estate.

Starting in 2022, Muriel and Aurélie are proud to continue their family's tradition, which represents an exciting evolution for both the estate and the village of Cumières.
